Data on Internet Service Providers (ISP) in Ontario, Wayne, Wyoming & Livingston Counties

Almost 99% of consumers in New York have access to a wired connection with true broadband speeds faster than 25 Mbps. The average download speed in New York is 104.71Mbps.

- There are an average of 6 residential internet providers per county.
- The average fastest speed available is 955Mbps. The average download speed is 40.12Mbps.
- The lowest starting price is \$27.99 /month for service at 6-90 Mbps from Frontier Communications.
- The highest starting price is \$59.99/month for service at 25Mbps from HughesNet.






